Developing Empathy

Essential Question: How does drama help us empathize with various characters and their struggles?

Objective: You will write a letter to a character in Fish in a Tree that gives advice, words of encouragement, or even warnings related to a character's particular problem.

Activity:

- Choose a character from Fish in a Tree.
- Write a letter to that character that offers them advice or gives them words of encouragement. You may even write a warning to the character about his/her particular problem.
- Formulate your letter in such a way that your character knows that you are empathizing with his/her situation. Your words should convey an honest message that allows them to feel that you truly care and are concerned about their current situation.
- Your letter should be a friendly letter addressed to the character in the book and the closing should be your own name.
- Grammar and spelling are important, but I am more so looking to feel

- Letter should be two paragraphs in length.
