

Participant Instructions and Information:

The 2023 Baltimore St. Patrick's Day Parade is scheduled for **Sunday, March 12**, **2023**. The parade will begin at 2:00 p.m. at the Washington Monument, and proceed down Charles Street, ending at Market Place (see attached parade route). Parade participants need to **arrive between 1:00 p.m. and 1:30 p.m.** Group leaders should check in at the Parade Registration Tent, located at the Washington Monument. Please let the folks at the check-in table know that you are with the Archdiocese of Baltimore School Students. They will direct you to our staging area (**Area 4**).

A few things to note for this year's parade:

- It is rain or shine. The Parade will not be cancelled due to inclement weather.
- School signs and banners are encouraged.
- The official Parade Mass is at 10:45 a.m. at the Baltimore Basilica, for those
 wishing to get an earlier start to the day. Archbishop Lori will be the principal
 celebrant.
- As always, chaperones and/or parents are responsible for the students in their school's delegation. This includes ensuring that children are returned safely to parents/guardians at the end of the parade.
- Parents/teachers/administrators are welcome to walk with students during the parade.
- Parade participants should wear their school uniform, school spirit gear, or school club attire.
- Green accessories (necklaces, hats, etc.) are encouraged.
- There is street and garage parking available. Carpooling is recommended.
- Please be aware that the Shamrock 5K Race takes place at 1:00 pm immediately before the Parade. We recommend getting downtown before the start of the Race to get the best parking spot.
