We look for specific ways to get ready to welcome the gift of the Christ Child's love into our homes and world. Prayer, activities, family discussion, reaching out to others- there are numerous ways to open ourselves to Christ's love and to share his love with others.



While we are preparing for Christmas by shopping, decorating, cooking, and planning family get-togethers, our seasonal scriptures focus on our preparations for the ultimate reunion.



Advent Wreath- an advent wreath helps us to mark the time in a prayerful way as we prepare for the Christ Child to be born anew in our hearts.

Family Discussions and Christmas Traditions- Whenever families share special moments, we focus on the true meaning of Christmas.

Christmas Cards- Keep cards in a basket and pull one out each night. Say a prayer for that person or family for the special "gift" they bring into your life.

ADVENT LITURGIES AND DEVOTIONS

During Advent, the liturgies encourage us to be still and reflect upon the presence of Christ within. The Church environment is simpler; the music is more restrained; the Gloria is omitted and the Penitential Rite is highlighted; the violet vestments suggest a more reflective anticipation of the approaching feast.
