The program is adaptive and will adjust based on your child's demonstrated understanding of the material. All of your child's results will be saved, so you can monitor their progress anytime by clicking on Analytics. For on-the-go practice, you can download IXL's free mobile app for Apple, Android, or Kindle and sign in with your child's username and password.

To access IXL, you will first need to please email Ms. Latkowsky at platkowsky@stmstc.org so that she can create the student(s) account on IXL. After that, you will follow the instructions listed below.

Current Students:

Log on to IXL using your username and password that are attached to this letter.

To get your child started on your home computer, please follow these easy steps:

- ★ Go to https://www.ixl.com
- ★ Enter your child's username and password (see attached) and click "Sign in."
- ★ Click on the grade your child has just completed and practice skills in math and ELA. Math skills should include all four operations with whole numbers, place values, and fractions.
- ★ ELA skills should focus on grammar as well as reading comprehension.
- ★ Students should strive for a score of at least 80% for each skill they complete.

For reading, the students are to choose a chapter book(s) of their choice to read over the summer. When they finish, they can write up a quick summary of the book,

telling me what it was about. They can also tell me what they liked about the story and what parts they didn't like. They can read as many books as they would like. It doesn't necessarily have to be a chapter book.
